**Ahreum Han** serves as the Director of Music and Organist at First Presbyterian Church of Fort Worth. She previously on organ faculty at Iowa State University in Ames, Iowa and the College Organist at Cornell College in Mount Vernon, Iowa. She also served as organist at Marquand Chapel of Yale Divinity School, an organist the Berkeley Divinity School of Yale University.

As a solo recitalists, Ahreum has performed at some extraordinary venues, including Oxford Town Hall (UK), Nottingham Albert Concert Hall (UK), Michealskirche (Leipzig, Germany), International Organ Festival in Arbon, Switzerland, Esplanade Hall in Singapore, Kimmel Center's Verizon Hall in Philadelphia, PA, and Spreckels Organ Pavilion in Balboa Park in San Diego, CA. Her live performances have been featured on the radio show PIPEDREAMS from American Public Media.

Born in Seoul, Korea, Ahreum immigrated with her family to Atlanta, Georgia, at the age sixteen. She holds a Bachelor's degree in organ performance from Westminster Choir College, a Diploma from prestigious Curtis Institute of Music, a Master's degree from Yale School of Music and Yale Institute of Sacred Music, and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from University of Iowa. Her teachers include Ed Dunbar, Ken Cowan, Alan Morrison, Thomas Murray, and Brett Wolgast.
